

AMA CBO Status Benefits

- For 86 years AMA has successfully managed the recreational community. This CBO status formally codifies AMA's role.
- The FAA acknowledges that AMA's Safety Program is the gold standard.
- CBO status validates and gives credibility to our safety program among stakeholders and regulators.
- CBO status gives AMA a formal seat at the table when the FAA addresses recreational operations.
- CBO status opens the door for additional advocacy efforts to include our continued efforts to secure altitudes and creates a pathway to fly without Remote ID modules through FAA-Recognized Identification Areas (FRIAs).
- FRIAs allow our members to fly at approved AMA flying fields without Remote ID broadcast modules. Members can continue flying at FRIAs as they always have with the same equipment they already use.
