- Age 12-19.
- Well-spoken and well informed.
- Active in youth aviation and club activities.
- Modeling background and expertise would be important, but not critical.

What will be expected if they choose to participate.

- Be an active, contributing participant in several online meetings in 2023 hosted by Randy Cameron with representation from the AMA Education department.
- Be part of an online presentation at one of the later 2023 EC meetings presenting the results of these meetings.

The topics of the meetings and the expected outcomes.

- How will permanent youth members of the Advisory board be chosen; how long will they serve and how will they be replaced.
- Determine how the AMA board, AMA Committees and membership would benefit from the work of a youth board and define a mission statement for that work going forward.

Directions to the EC members.

- You can nominate more than one person in your district. Designate which is your first choice.
- Youth who have attended Camp AMA might be good choices.
